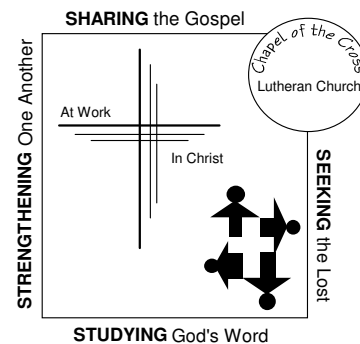

#### **NEW BIBLE STUDY: How do I share my faith in this world?**

During the month of June, Vicar Mark will be doing a Bible study on Evangelism. For various reasons, Evangelism is a touchy subject for many of us. It's something that we either don't want to talk about, or don't like to talk about. But, we know and understand that Jesus Christ has made us a light to the world, a light to shine in the darkness. We are beacons of hope for a lost world. It is our job not only to "act" Christian, but to profess Christ by our words. The series of Sunday morning Bible studies beginning June 6 will help us understand Biblical ideas of Evangelism, understandings and misunderstandings, helpful tips and methods, and learning the importance of context and culture. The Bible studies will climax in our going out on June 20 into a local neighborhood during the late afternoon or early evening to hand out Vacation Bible School information to invite people to attend. For those of you who, because of health concerns or disabilities, cannot go out into the neighborhood, you are invited to stay at Chapel during that time to pray for the success of our efforts or help in other ways. We shouldn't be out longer than about an hour. During our last Bible study on June 27, we will discuss our experiences and tie up any loose ends. Everyone is invited and encouraged to attend – everyone from youth to older adults!
