SUNDAY MORNINGS AT CHAPEL, beginning TODAY, SEPT 19

1. Sunday Morning for our Children and Youth:

We invite you to join us for our Sunday School opening in the Gym at 9:25 a.m. each Sunday. Here we sing a kid friendly song, hear about the lesson that the kids will be learning about, and recognize birthdays. This year all 5th-12th graders are also encouraged to participate in the youth choir at this same time before class starts with Pastor Clausing and his guitar. They will meet in Daniel's Den (The High School Youth Room) and are encouraged to begin meeting as soon as the 8 a.m. service is over.

We have an awesome Sunday School staff which provides loving, biblical, Christ-centered teaching for all ages. Our Sunday School begins at age three and goes through 8th grade. The Mom's and Babes class in our nursery offers a place for children younger than three to be with their moms and/or a nursery attendant.
