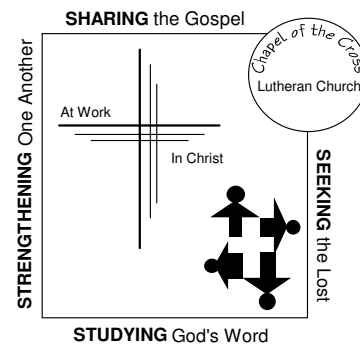

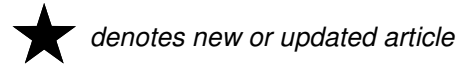
PLEASE NOTE: if you are scheduled for tests or surgery, or any need where you would like the Pastor to be present, **please call the church office** so that this may be arranged.

## OUR BIBLE STUDIES



**Sun:** We invite you to join us for our Sunday School opening in the Gym at 9:25 a.m. each Sunday. Here we sing a kid friendly song, hear about the lesson that the kids will be learning about, and recognize birthdays. This year all 5<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders are also encouraged to participate in the youth choir at this same time before class starts with Pastor Clausing and his guitar. They will meet in Daniel's Den (The High School Youth Room) and are encouraged to begin meeting as soon as the 8 a.m. service is over.
