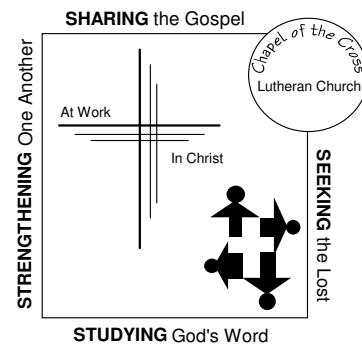

December 8th 6-7:30pm

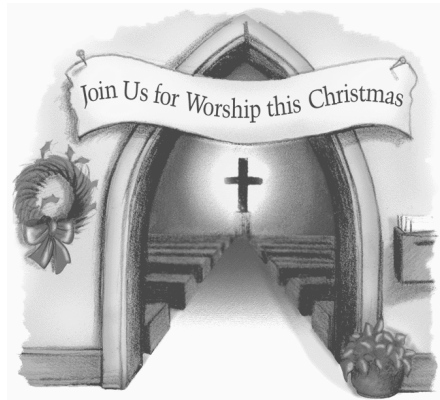
CHRISTMAS CAROLING AND WASSAIL
