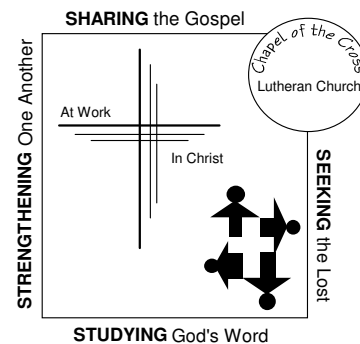

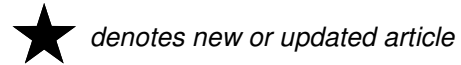

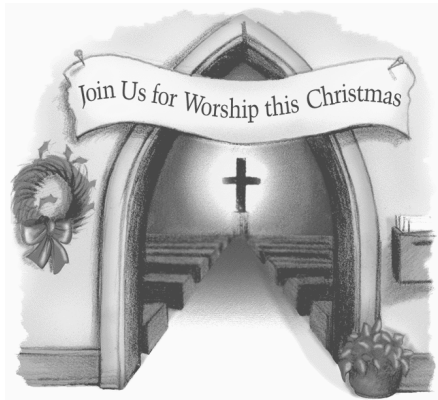
BRUNSWICK ZONE CHRISTMAS PARTY
