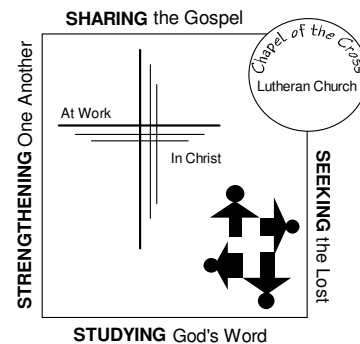

Adult Bibles Studies

Revelation: In this study you will learn what God's Word really says about the end of the world. You will learn what all the numbers and symbols really mean so that you will not be led astray by all the crazy teachings out there. This bible study will meet in the large room of the upper level of the new education wing and will be led by Pastor Bob Hoehner

Christian Basics: In this study you will look at the six chief parts of the Historic Christian Faith: The Ten Commandments, The Apostles' Creed, The Lord's Prayer, Holy Baptism, Confession and Absolution, and The Lord's Supper. This class will also lead to Adult confirmation and church membership. This class will meet in the smaller new classroom on the upper level and will be led by Pastor Mark Hoehner

Esther: This is an awesome women's bible study for all ages written by Beth Moore. If you have a baby or toddler that is not of the age to go to Sunday School, bring him or her here! We have a nursery attendant and you will be only a couple of feet from your child! This class meets in the lower level of the new education wing.

Sunday School for youth and children:

1. **3yr old to going into 1st grade** will "JOURNEY WITH JESUS" We will join God's people in the Old and New Testaments as they go on a journey. No matter where God's people go, their journey has the same purpose, leading them - and you and me - to our Savior and our home in heaven. Don't miss our fun games, snacks, crafts and songs! Have your child bring a friend! This class meets in the lower level of the new education wing.
2. **Going into 2nd – going into 5th** : These kids will also "JOURNEY WITH JESUS" We will join God's people in the Old and New Testaments as they go on a journey. This class will meet in Rm 12 in the lower level.

3. **Jr. high book club in the library:** This is a new Sunday School class being offered this week. Kids will be lead in the reading of books from the *Chronicles of Narnia Series*.
