

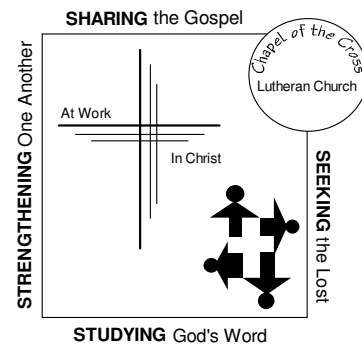

### **WANT TO KNOW MORE ABOUT THE END OF THE WORLD?**

#### **Adult Bibles Studies**

**Revelation:** In this study you will learn what God's Word really says about the end of the world. You will learn what all the numbers and symbols really mean so that you will not be led astray by all the crazy teachings out there. This bible study will meet in the large room of the upper level of the new education wing and will be led by Rev Jon Clausing.
