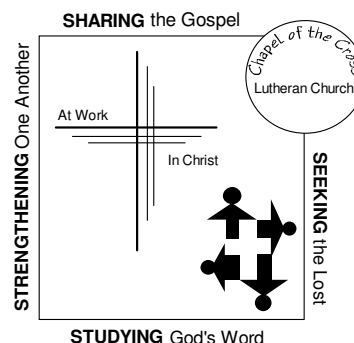

We are pleased to now have an AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) available at Chapel of the Cross. An AED is a device used in medical emergencies to “shock” a person’s heart and resuscitate an adult or child with a sudden cardiac emergency. It is designed to be used by non-medical people and we now have members of Chapel who have completed training to use the AED.

We pray that we never have to use it, but thank God that we have it available if we ever need it. We want to make everyone aware that the AED is available and where it’s located.

**The AED is located in a wall mounted cabinet in the hall just off the coffee shoppe.**
