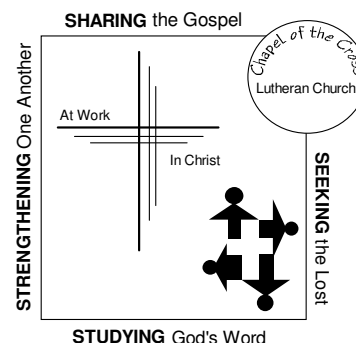

## OUR BIBLE STUDIES

**Sun: JOIN US FOR ADULT BIBLE CLASSES AT 9:35 A.M.**

## AED INFO

We are pleased to now have an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) available at Chapel of the Cross. An AED is a medical device used in medical emergencies to “shock” an adult or child’s heart in a sudden cardiac emergency.

We have a group of members of Chapel who have completed training to use the AED. (The list of trained users is posted on the side of the AED, or you may contact the Parish Nurses thru the church office if you have any questions about the AED or it’s use.)

There may also be other members of the congregation who have received AED training elsewhere (thru an employer or as part of a first aid/CPR class) or are familiar with the use of an AED.

We want to make everyone aware that the AED is available and where it is located. (In an emergency, anyone may be asked to go get the AED and bring it to the location of the emergency.)

**The AED is located in a wall mounted cabinet in the hall just off the Coffee Shoppe. An alarm will sound when the door is opened—simply close the door to silence the alarm. As in any emergency, 911 should be called immediately.**

An important feature of the AED is that even non-trained or non-medical people can use it successfully in an emergency. The AED actually “talks” a user through an emergency situation with audio prompts. It is very safe to use and is designed to be able to be used by anyone in an emergency situation.

## **THANK YOU!!!**

The Parish Nurses want to extend a big Thank You to the Chapel Circle and the Sausage Supper for contributing funds for the purchase of the AED. This is literally a life-saving device and we thank you for helping make it available to our church family.
