

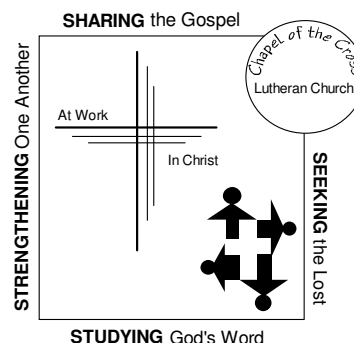

## OUR BIBLE STUDIES

1. **God Wins: Pastor James Uglum** — A four week apologetic study focusing on this question: Does a loving God really send some people to hell?
