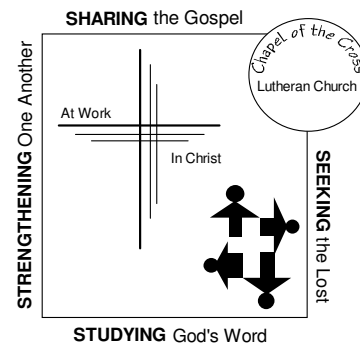

### **Summer Bible Study**

**Systematic Theology 101** — Question: “What is systematic theology?”

Answer: “Systematic” refers to something being put into a system. Systematic theology is, therefore, the division of theology into systems that explain its various areas. For example, many books of the Bible give information about the angels. No one book gives all the information about the angels. Systematic theology takes all the information about Angels from all the books of the Bible and organizes it into a single teaching on Angels. That is what systematic theology is all about — organizing the teachings of the Bible into categorical systems. Join Pastor James this summer for a closer look at this and many other exciting topics.
