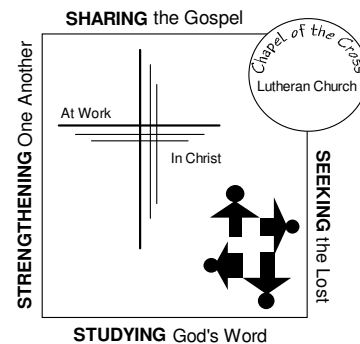

Our Summer Bible Studies

- **Overview of the New Testament** — Do you want to know more about how each of the 4 Gospels are similar and also different? Why do we read from these Gospels and not “other Gospels?” And why was St. Paul writing to the Romans and Galatians and Ephesians, and how were his writings similar or different from St. Peter’s writings? And who were James and Jude? These questions and more will be discussed in this class this summer. Come and bring your bible and a friend!
Room B Upper Level with Pastor Mark Hoehner
- **Apologetics 101** — There are plenty of objections to Christianity and becoming a Christian, but there are just as many answers. As Christians we should “always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But to do it with gentleness and respect” (1 Peter 3:15). Join Pastor James this summer as we take a closer look at some of the major objections and questions that people have about the faith (evolution, the existence of God, the trustworthiness of the Bible, homosexuality, stem-cell research . . .) and how we as Christians should respond to each.
Room D, lower level with Pastor James Uglum
- **Chronicles of Narnia** — Many generations have come to know and love the stories of C.S. Lewis collectively known as the Chronicles of Narnia. During this summer long study, we will see how a creative storyteller, and former atheist, wove the teachings of God’s Word into stories of adventure, courage, and faith. Our study will begin with *The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe* and continue with *Prince Caspian*, and *Voyage of the Dawn Treader*. Participants are invited to read these books, but it is not required. We will also be incorporating video clips from the Disney film versions into our discussions.
