A HUGE THANK YOU TO THE CONGREGATION

from Chapel's YOUTH GROUP

We'd like to thank you for blessing our Tampa Mission Trip with your support and prayers. The trip was successful, fulfilling, and yes, even lots of fun.

Half of our group held VBS for MIGRANT MINISTRIES, where the children had very limited or no English at all. Most of these children came hungry to VBS, having had no breakfast available to them at home. It was heart-wrenching to hear their stories and to know their needs. It was rewarding to hear some of them speak their first word, and sad to see them cry when our group's bus left on the last day.

The other half of our group worked at METROPLITAN MINISTRIES, a homeless shelter and warehouse where various donations are taken in. The group sorted and sifted through donations, cleaned areas in the facility, and prepared meals for the homeless. They also worked at Feeding America for 2-1/2 days sorting through (processing) foods donated by individuals, stores, and companies. We processed nearly 36,000 pounds of dry food, 1000 pounds of produce and fresh/frozen meat. That amounted to 22,833 meals! It was really awesome to see the whole operation, from the food coming in, being separated, sent out, or shopped.

Be sure to look at the bulletin board in the Coffee Shoppe or Chapel's website to see pictures of our week's events. Better yet, if you see one of our youth, ask them about their "highs and lows" of the trip.
