Our church has agreed to assist THE SPARROW'S NEST MATERNITY HOME by participating in a Baby Bottle Campaign for 5 weeks. Here is a message from the NEST that explains how a Baby Bottle Campaign helps homeless pregnant teenagers:

"Many times it can be hard to know how to get involved or how to contribute to an organization you truly believe in. But what if I told you that you could make a great contribution by just filling a baby bottle with your pocket change? Every baby bottle filled with the change from your couch cushions or cup holders can add up to about \$22! That's awesome especially when you consider that it takes \$115 a day to provide housing for a teen mom and her baby. That's a simple 5 bottles a day full of pocket change to give a young lady security, hope, structure and love in a Christ centered home as she chooses to give her child life. Collecting change can be a simple way to make a difference!"

We hope each family at Chapel will pick up a Baby Bottle from the Coffee Shop and begin to fill it with change. Sit it on your dinner table, snack bar or bathroom sink as a reminder to add to it daily. Bottles will be available beginning **Sunday, February 14** and will need to be returned to the church by **Sunday, March 6.** **Thank you for your support of babies and teen moms.**
