The Lutheran High School Annual Golf Tournament is just two weeks away on

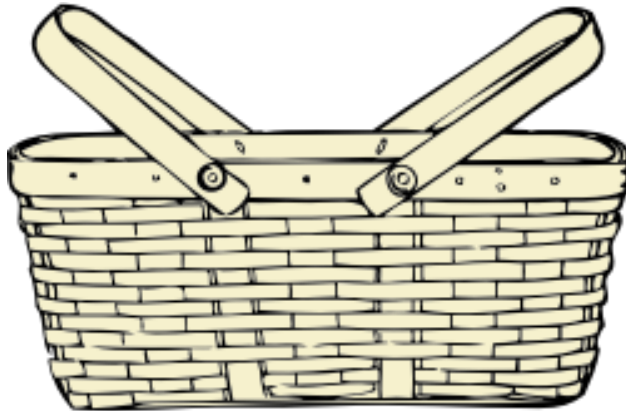
