DIABETES MANAGEMENT

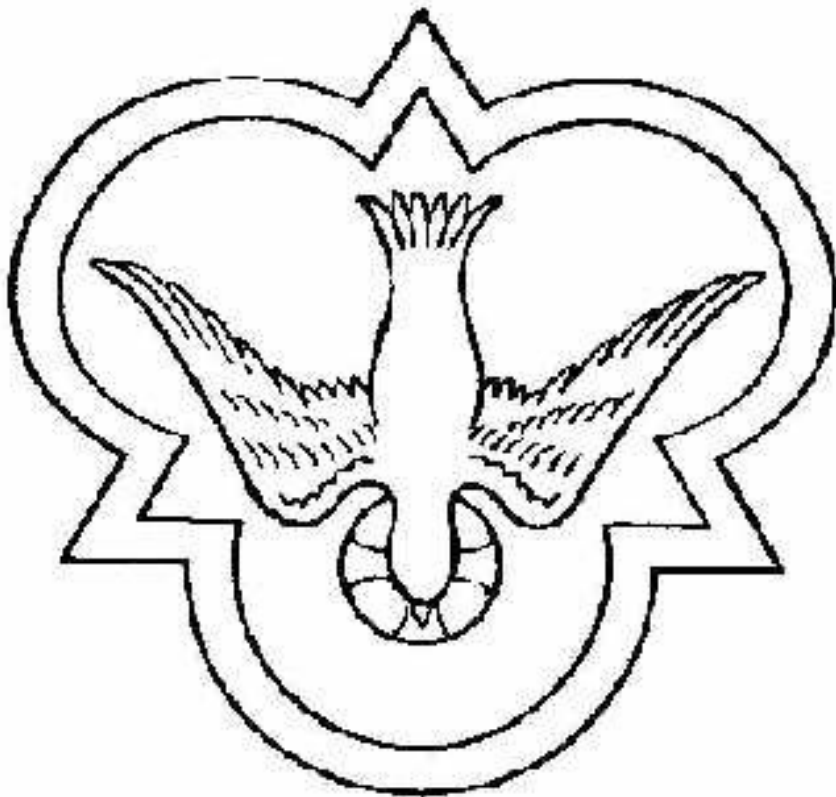
