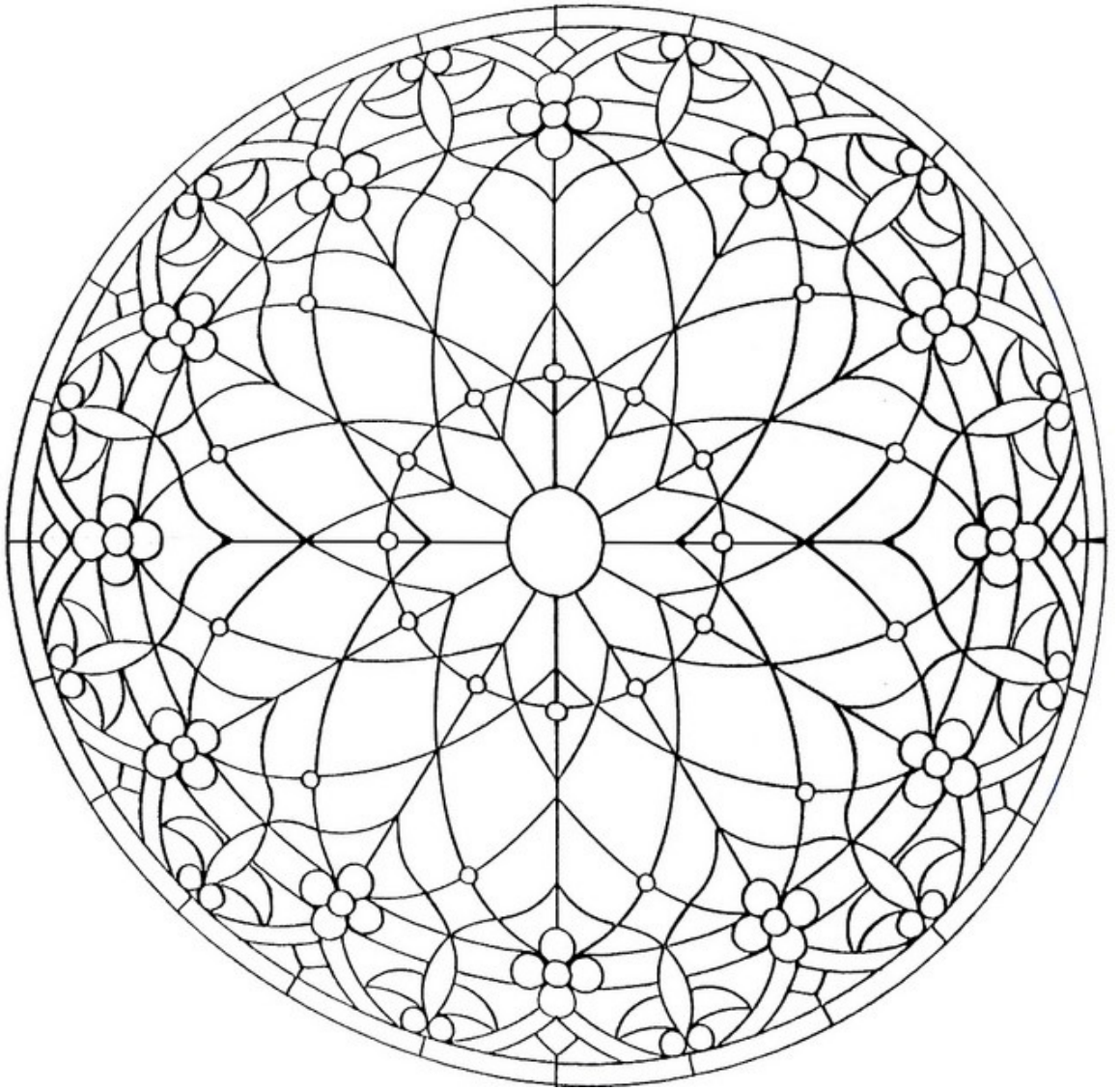


## **GOOD NEIGHBOR PROGRAM SEEKING CAREGIVERS**
