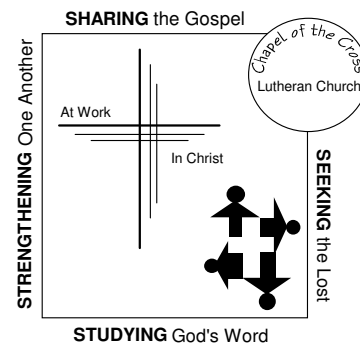

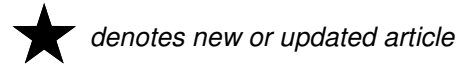
PLEASE NOTE: if you are scheduled for tests or surgery, or any need where you would like the Pastor to be present, **please call the church office** so that this may be arranged.

SUNDAY MORNINGS AT CHAPEL, beginning SEPT 19

1. Sunday Morning for our Children and Youth:

We invite you to join us for our Sunday School opening in the Gym at 9:25 a.m. each Sunday. Here we sing a kid friendly song, hear about the lesson that the kids will be learning about, and recognize birthdays. This year all 5th-12th graders are also encouraged to participate in the youth choir at this same time before class starts with Pastor Clausing and his guitar. They will meet in Daniel's Den (The High School Youth Room) and are encouraged to begin meeting as soon as the 8 a.m. service is over.

We have an awesome Sunday School staff which provides loving, biblical, Christ-centered teaching for all ages. Our Sunday School begins at age three and goes through 8th grade. The Mom's and Babes class in our nursery offers a place for children younger than three to be with their moms and/or a nursery attendant. Our High School Youth meet in Daniel's Den with Pastor James, after the opening song time. All kids are welcomed and encouraged to bring a friend.

2. Sunday Morning Adult Bible Studies Include:

1 Samuel with Pastor Hoehner in the Gym. Come learn about one of the most fascinating time periods in Biblical history and world history. "In those days the word of the Lord was rare . . ." the book begins. Not only had God stopped speaking to His people, the leadership of God's people stopped leading according to God's Word. Yet, God was still actively working among His people. Come see how God raises up his prophet Samuel and His anointed King David to not only lead Israel back into relationship with God, but to point Israel to the ultimate act of God's Salvation – the birth of the ultimate Son of David - Jesus of Nazareth. Only this Son of David would be born true Man and true God – only He could save Israel and all of the world from sin, death, and the devil!

Christian Basics with Pastor Scholle in the Sanctuary.
