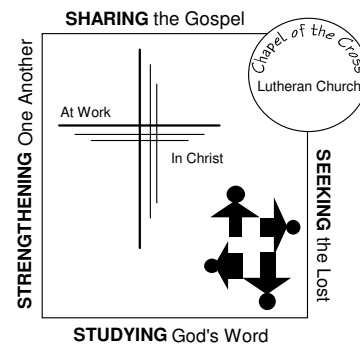

**Sun:** We invite you to join us for our Sunday School opening in the Gym at 9:25 a.m. each Sunday. 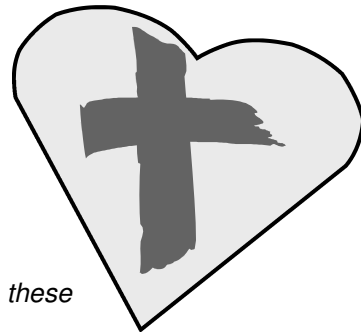
## WEDS NIGHT BIBLE CLASS

Scouting For Food is 1 ½ months away but the Need is Urgent Now!**
