### **NEW SUNDAY MORNING BIBLE CLASS--ALPHA GROUP BEGINNING FEBRUARY 4 IN ROOM 222**

What is Alpha Group? Alpha is the first letter of the Greek alphabet. This letter is often used as a metaphor as the "most important" or "most foundational" of things.

This class discusses how:

1. Jesus is the most important being, the only true God in your world
2. Jesus has a most important plan for your life
3. Jesus has created the world and the sciences to serve you, and you to serve the world
4. Jesus delivers His most important love into you by created means attached to His promises

We have completed all the City and State permitting. Repairs will begin on the beam within the next 2-3 weeks. Currently, the steel components that will brace and strengthen the beam are being fabricated. We will do our best to not disrupt any church events. Once the repair is complete, we will then work on covering the outside sections to avoid any future damage. Also, this is a good time to remind everyone that this is a **\$45,000 unanticipated expense** and that we have set up a designated fund for anyone who would like to help defray the costs. Just mark BEAM on the note field of your check or envelope. It would be great if we could collectively lessen the impact of this repair on our emergency funds.
