BEAM REPAIR PROJECT

The search for the right company to do the fabrication and installation work for covering the beams is complete, with the contract going to Architectural Sheet Metal Systems of St. Louis. ASMS is a well known company, over 35 years in business and had done work for the airport, Monsanto, the brewery, Mallinckrodt and many other local companies. As a bonus, the owners are Lutheran. The contract amount is \$17,905.00...higher than we had planned, but for perspective, one bid was for \$137,000.00.

Work should begin through the summer months and then we can put this one to bed, once and for all. Seeing the work occurring, hopefully, can also serve as a reminder that the "beam fund" is still open for donations.
